Her passion lies in enhancing intercultural understanding, embracing diversity and intentionally creating inclusive schools.







Course 1

Building and Leading teams

We know that building and leading an effective team is an important step in enabling individual and collective success. Middle leaders are often described as the engine room of a school because they work with senior leaders and teachers to translate the school's vision into reality for learners. As a middle leader, you cannot lead alone, and this course explores how middle leaders can create cohesive and collaborative teams that are mission driven.

The course draws on an extensive body of literature and research in order identify what is most useful, practical and productive in leading effective teams. From building trust to running an effective meeting, this course translates relevant theory into practical solutions that work.

The nature and scope of a middle leadership role is wide-ranging; middle leaders need to build and develop the knowledge, skills, understanding and behaviours to bring out the best in themselves and others. This course will empower participants to create the conditions that enable them to collaborate, inspire and grow their team in order to transform learning.

Why is this course unique?

- 1. It is delivered by educators with significant experience of building and leading teams.
- 2. It explores contemporary research and literature about building and leading teams and identifies how schools leaders can apply it in their context.
- 3. It is practical and participants will leave with the confidence and 'know how' to lead a team effectively.
- 4.It is tailored to the Indian context and works for schools that follow the Indian Curriculum, Cambridge International curriculum and IB curriculum.
- 5. It provides opportunities to learn, share and connect beyond the training through our ECIS Middle Leader Café and Middle Leader LinkedIn Group.

Session 1: What makes a highly effective team?

This session unites the collective wisdom of the group to explore what makes a highly effective team. It draws on key research and the experience of the group about what works and what doesn't work. By the end of the session, participants will have a shared understanding of what makes a great team.

Session 2: What are the key components of successful team development?

This session identifies the key features of successful team development with a deep dive into concepts that include: trust, safety, belonging and accountability. With a focus on building strong foundations, participants will truly begin to understand how building strong foundations can optimise team effectiveness.

Session 3: How can I facilitate the creation of a team focused on student learning?

As a leader, one of the most difficult challenges is prioritising what matters and 'keeping the main thing the main thing'. This session concentrates on keeping student learning at the heart of the work of the team and explores how middle leaders can motivate and influence their team to improve learning.

Structured plenary

In the structured plenary, participants will have the opportunity to reflect on their learning and identify actionable next steps. There will also be time for Q and A.

Session 4: How can I make the most of meetings with my team?

We know that teachers and leaders spend a lot of time in meetings. When those meetings are poor, this can lead to frustration and poor motivation. This session equips middle leaders with a range of effective meeting strategies including identifying roles and responsibilities, setting norms, creating agendas and using facilitation to make sure that everyone has a voice.

Session 5: What types of conversations are critical, and when are they likely to occur?

Conflict is inevitable, combat is optional and communication is essential. This session explores how leaders can begin to manage and embrace conflict within their teams, By the end of this session, participants will have a range of communication strategies to make every conversation count.

Session 6: How can I lead change successfully and secure impact.

Kotter stated that 'change is a process and not an event'. We know that change provokes an emotional response. As a leader, managing these responses and your own feelings and emotions can be difficult. This session unpacks a range of strategies for change so that it is purposeful and impactful.

Course 2

Coaching & Leadership

Coaching is an important leadership approach for teacher leaders because it focuses on getting the best out of people by unlocking and unleashing their potential. In an educational context, coaching is about developing people so that they are empowered to solve problems and navigate their way through challenge and change. It supports well-being and gives people the skills and confidence to have better conversations and figure things out.

At an organisational level, coaching is pivotal to continuous and sustainable development. This course will equip leaders to develop the beliefs, knowledge, skills and understanding to adopt a coaching approach in their everyday practice.

During the course, participants will explore key coaching theory and have multiple opportunities to translate this into practice using a 'hands on' approach. We will explore how effective coaches listen well and ask powerful questions. Across the four sessions, participants will build a toolkit of strategies and approaches apply in their own context. They will leave the course with the confidence and skills to become a 'coaching leader'.

Key questions

- 1. What is coaching and how can we develop a coaching mindset?
- 2. What is the role of listening in coaching and why does it matter?
- 3. How can asking better questions enable better conversations?
- 4. How can we use coaching in our day to day work as leaders?
- 5. What models, tools and techniques do we need in our coaching toolkit?
- 6. Coaching in action: practising and applying our learning.

Why is this course unique?

- 1. It is delivered by expert, experienced and accredited coaches.
- 2. It translates the latest research and literature about coaching into practice.
- 3. It is 'hands on' and participants will leave with the knowledge, skills and understanding to be an effective coaching leader.
- 4.It is tailored to the Indian context and works for schools that follow the Indian Curriculum, Cambridge International curriculum and IB curriculum.

Session 1: What is coaching and how can we develop a coaching mindset?

This session explores what coaching is and how it differs from mentoring. Participants will explore what makes an effective coach and understand why coaching is an effective leadership style in terms of sustainable and impactful change.

Session 2: What is effective listening and why does it matter?

This session unpacks how leaders can increase their listening capacity and how effective listening builds trust, improves communication and drives improvement. They will build a toolkit of strategies for better listening and practise their listening skills in pairs and small groups.

Session 3: How can asking better questions enable better conversations?

This session cements the belief that people are resourceful and can find the answers within themselves. By the end of this session, participants will be confident in using a range of questioning techniques that empower others to be effective and figure things out. Participants will also undertake a walking talking coaching practice.

Structured plenary

In the structured plenary, participants will have the opportunity to reflect on their learning and identify actionable next steps. There will also be time for Q and A.

Session 4: How can we use coaching in our day to day work as leaders?

This session considers how leaders can integrate coaching into their day to day work and routines. Whether participants are working with parents and carers, giving lesson observation feedback or having a 1-1, coaching can support middle leaders to have better conversations.

Session 5: What models, tools and techniques do we need in our coaching toolkit?

This session will explore different coaching models, tools and techniques including a Solutions Based Coaching approach. They will develop a clear understanding of how each model can be applied and begin to build their coaching toolkit.



SESSION DESCRIPTIONS

Session 6: Coaching in action: practising and applying our learning.

In this session, participants will work in triads to put their learning into practice. They will participate in a coaching set where everyone will have the chance to be coach, coachee and observer. A through debrief will help them to identify what went well and next steps.
