Course 1 / The Culture of Leadership

- Developing others through mentoring and shared leadership to ensure lasting impact.

Conflict, when managed effectively, can drive growth and strengthen relationships. This course provides middle leaders with practical strategies for navigating difficult conversations and fostering a culture of open communication. Key areas covered include:

4. NECTAR: Academic Research Connect & Immersion

Faculty Development Programme by Jio Institute in collaboration with AICTE
AI & Data Science: Perspectives, Pedagogy & Practices
